### October 8-12, 2026

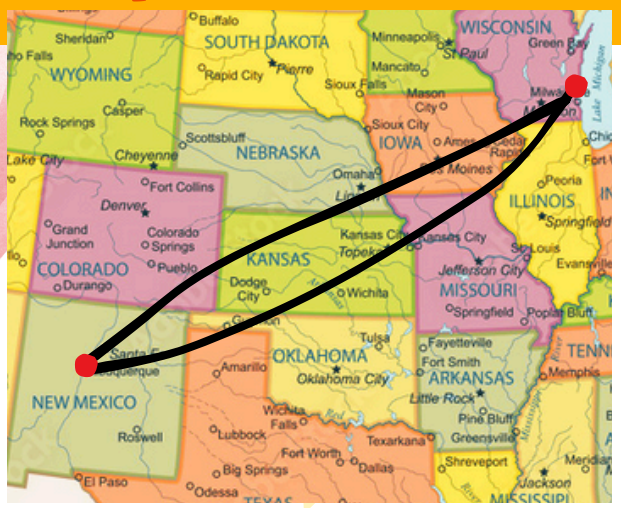

**Thursday, Oct. 8th** - We land in Albuquerque and meet our local tour director and get ready to be whisked away to our hotel for a quick refresh. But don't get too comfortable! Tonight, we are off to **Balloon Fiesta Park** to dive straight into the excitement. Dinner at the **Chasers Club** offers prime access to the dazzling **Special Shape Glowdeo**-where balloons flow in the night sky like vibrant works of art-and the **AfterGlow Fireworks Show**, an unforgettable symphony of light. This magical spectacle is a highlight of the Fiesta, lighting up the sky in pure New Mexico style. **D**

**Friday, Oct. 9th** - We will start the day with a treasure hunt through the **Turquoise Museum**, where we'll walk through a replica mine tunnel, exploring natural formations of the precious gemstone. Then we take a fascinating deep dive into New Mexico's rich history at the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center**. Afterward, enjoy a **scenic tour** of Albuquerque, taking in the iconic **University of New Mexico**, the vibrant downtown, and the charming street of **Old Town**. In the afternoon, ascend to **Sandia Peak** via the world-renowned tramway, for panoramic views of the landscape. **B**

**Saturday, Oct. 10th** - Today, we discover why Albuquerque is the **Balloon Capital of the World!** Rise early to witness the breathtaking **Dawn Patrol**, where balloonists take flight before sunrise, guided only by their position lights. Experience the world-famous **Mass Ascension**, where hundreds of colorful balloons take to the sky. Enjoy breakfast with a front-row seat to the action. After the fiesta, we head to the sacred **Acoma Pueblo**, known as **Sky Club**. Take a guided tour through this ancient village, still home to generations of Native American families, and explore the stunning art, pottery, and cultural exhibits. **B, L**

**Sunday, Oct. 11th** - Pack your bags for a scenic day trip to **Santa Fe**, the oldest state capital in the U.S. Founded in 1609, Santa Fe is a resounding blend of historic landmarks and artistic flair. Our tour will showcase sights including the **Santa Fe Plaza**, the **Palace of the Governors**, the **Loretto Chapel**, and the **San Miguel Mission**, the oldest church in the U.S. Free time to explore the galleries, shops, and the **Indian Market**. **B**

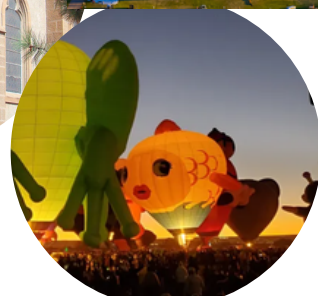
