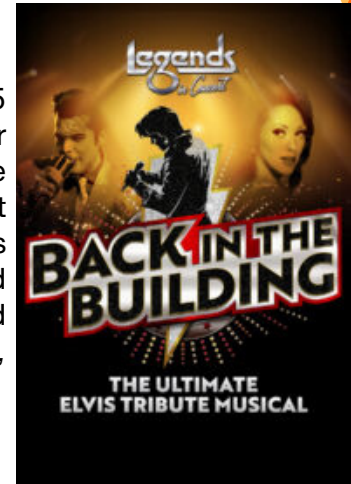

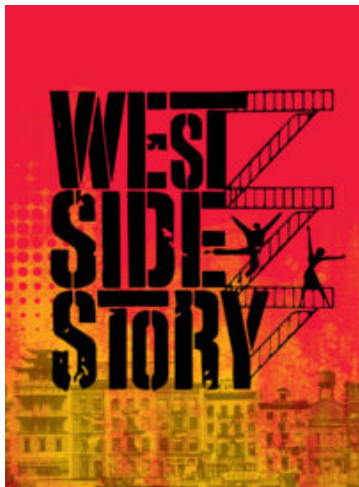
## BACK IN THE BUILDING – ELVIS Jan. 30, 2025

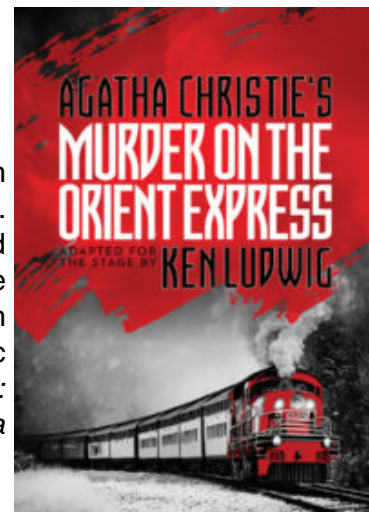
## WEST SIDE STORY Mar. 13, 2025

## MURDER ON THE ORIENT EXPRESS May 8 2025

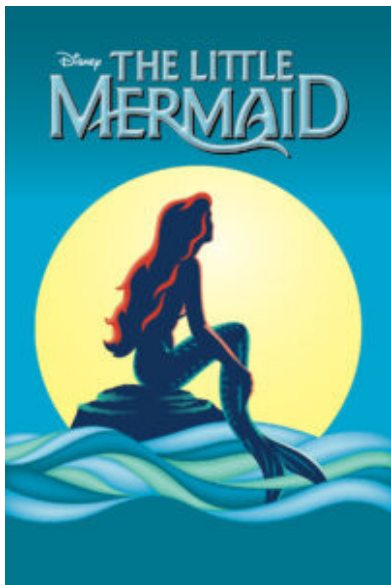

# THE LITTLE MERMAID

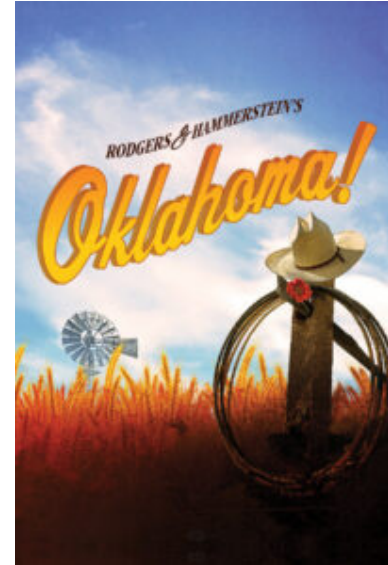

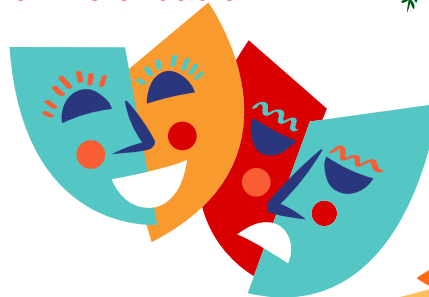
