Tuesday, Oct. 13 - Our journey begins as we head southeast toward Charleston, West Virginia. Settle in, get to know your fellow travelers, and enjoy a welcome dinner this evening. (D)

Wednesday, Oct. 14 - Today we travel through the scenic Blue Ridge region to historic Charlottesville, Virginia. Enjoy a hearty lunch at the famous Michie Tavern, a colonial-style dining experience that's sure to impress. Then, step into the world of Thomas Jefferson with a guided visit to Monticello, his stunning mountaintop home. (B, L)

Thursday, Oct. 15 - En route to Williamsburg, we'll stop at Montpelier, the beautifully restored home of President James Madison. Then, it's on to the colonial capital of Williamsburg! Enjoy a free afternoon to wander the historic streets and shops before we regroup for a guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg and a memorable dinner in one of its historic taverns. **(B, D)**

Friday, Oct. 16 - Today is packed with America's earliest stories! We begin at Historic Jamestown, the first permanent English settlement, followed by a visit to Yorktown Battlefield, where the American Revolution came to a dramatic close. Enjoy a picturesque drive along the Colonial Parkway ("Red" Drive) and explore the shops and views along Yorktown's Riverwalk Landing before dinner. **(B, L)**

Saturday, Oct. 17 - On the road to the capital, we'll stop in Richmond, Virginia's vibrant and historic capital. Then it's off to Mount Vernon, George Washington's beloved estate. Enjoy a guided house tour, time to explore the beautifully preserved grounds, and a colonial-inspired lunch on site. We arrive in Washington, D.C. this evening. **(B, L)**

Sunday, Oct. 18 - Dive into the nation's history with visits to Ford's Theatre and the Petersen House, where Lincoln's legacy still lingers. The afternoon is yours to explore the Smithsonian Museums, Capitol grounds, or National Mall at your own pace. You may also choose to join an optional guided city bus tour with stops including the National Air & Space Museum with your guide, Herman. **(B, L)**

Monday, Oct. 19 - As we head north, we'll pass through Baltimore, stopping to tour the star-shaped Fort McHenry, where the Star-Spangled Banner was born. Then, step into Revolutionary history at the Betsy Ross House in Philadelphia, and conclude the day at Fort Mercer, overlooking the Delaware River. **(B)**

Tuesday, Oct. 20 - This morning, visit the historic grounds of Valley Forge with a knowledgeable guide, walking in the footsteps of Washington's Continental Army. Then it's westward to Pittsburgh, with a fascinating stop at the Fort Ligonier Museum, a French and Indian War-era fortification. **(B)**

Wednesday, Oct. 21 - As we make our way back, we'll travel through Amish country, where a delicious farewell luncheon awaits. Reflect on the people, places, and powerful stories you've encountered on this unforgettable journey through America's past. **(B, L)**
