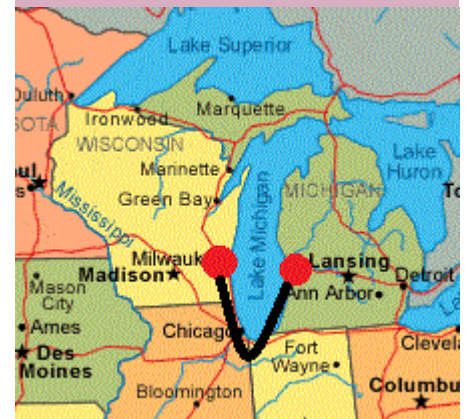

**Thursday, May 7th**— This morning we depart for Tulip Time in Holland, Michigan on this weekend getaway. 2026 marks the 97th year of this floral festival. Beginning in 1929, the city of Holland planted its first crop of 100,000 tulips and hundreds of visitors flocked to the small town for a glimpse of the colorful blooms. Since then, the festival has grown leaps and bounds into the bountiful extravaganza it is today. Our first stop is a new attraction: **Dutch Life on Display**, which showcases such things as dancing, historical demonstrations, and local food. We check into our home away from home, the Hampton Inn, conveniently located minutes away. After an included dinner we take our reserved seats for 3-time Emmy award winners and Billboard #1 recording artists, **The Texas Tenors**. These classically trained, versatile tenors' incredible vocals, humor, and cowboy charm will leave you wanting more! We stay right in Holland so a short ride has us tucked in for the night or able to enjoy a nightcap with friends. (D)

**Friday, May 8th**— After a delicious breakfast at our hotel, we meet our local guide for a **guided tour** of the area. Enjoy learning about the history and heritage of this unique cultural hotspot. Next we head to Beechwood Church for their **quilt show** and over 100 exquisite quilts and wall hangings. Our lunch today has a **Dutch flavor** along with **Dutch dancers**. After lunch we are whisked away to experience more spectacular sights, sounds, and smells. Tonight will be an extra special evening with **Michael Carbonaro**, an actor, magician, and improv artist who blends humor and magic in his hidden-camera series. Expect to be amazed and entertained. **Saturday, May 9th**— **Windmill Island Gardens**, home to the only authentic Dutch windmill operating in the United States, still turning and grinding wheat into flour! Other Dutch features include stately Friesian horses, a water exhibit, Little Netherlands, and of course, thousands of tulips! We are off to one of the main attractions of the festival— **The Volksparade!** With a name meaning “the people’s parade,” it is not hard to imagine that this parade is an ode to the people, past and present, who created this historic town and it pays homage to their Dutch culture. It is well-known for its tradition of “street-sweeping” before floats can come through. Local volunteers walk the path with brooms and water to wash the street before the floats and entertainers. After the parade, we are treated to a 90-minute performance of **Suite Surrender**. Through mistaken identities, overblown egos, and double entendres this roller-coaster of a play is a hilarious riot and a love note to the classic farces of the 30s and 40s. (B)

**Sunday, May 10th**— Today we begin our journey back home with some fun stops along the way. We will make a stop at the **Veldheer Tulip Gardens** to view some spectacular blooms (is there anything better on Mother’s Day?). After spending some time at the gardens, we begin our final stretch of our journey home. What a spectacular weekend! (B)
