
THE MIGHTY FIVE & MORE EXPLORING THE SOUTHWEST OCTOBER 5-12, 2025

Monday, October 6 - After breakfast, we say goodbye to Las Vegas and depart for the captivating landscapes of Utah's Color Country, making our way to the renowned Grand Staircase. Our journey continues to Zion National Park, where towering sandstone cliffs and verdant valleys create a paradise for nature lovers. Upon arrival, we'll enjoy a delightful lunch before you embark on a day of exploration in the park. Hike the scenic trails, marvel at the unique rock formations, and immerse yourself in Zion's serene beauty. As the day winds down, we'll travel to Bryce Canyon for an overnight stay, setting the stage for another day of adventure amidst breathtaking natural wonders. (B,L,D)

The afternoon is yours to enjoy as you wish—embark on an optional guided hike to delve deeper into the park's wonders or simply unwind and soak in the serene surroundings at the hotel. **(B)**

Wednesday, October 8 - We embark on a picturesque drive along Scenic Highway 12, a route renowned for its breathtaking vistas. Our journey takes us through the heart of the Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument, a vast and rugged landscape marked by stunning geological formations, including dramatic cliffs, deep canyons, and expansive plateaus. Our travels continue to **Page**, where we overlook the stunning Lake Powell National Recreation Area. The day culminates with an enchanting **Indian dinner and show**, offering a captivating blend of traditional Navajo cuisine and cultural performances. **(B,L,D)**

<u>Saturday, October 11</u> - Prepare for an exhilarating off-road adventure through the stunning desert scenery. We'll embark on an open-air **4x4 truck tour** of the **Secret Slot Canyons**, where towering sandstone walls create breathtaking passages waiting to be explored. After our adventure, enjoy a leisurely lunch on your own before we continue our journey to the majestic **Grand Canyon National Park**.
