Day 3 Travel to the **Thousand Island Bridge, Early Settlers' Museum, Alexandria Bay Lunch Cruise and Bolt Castle**. Tour of **Antique Boat Museum**. Shore dinner before returning to hotel. (B, L)

Day 4 Depart Hotel for **Great Camp Sagamore** and Adirondack Mountain region. **Adirondack Experience at Blue Mountain Lake**. Arrival in Lake Placid for our hotel accommodations. (B, D)

Day 5 City tour of **Lake Placid** (maybe even meet an Olympian!), **The Olympic Site Mirror Lake Inn** and more. Afternoon is yours to explore. Dinner at a true **trout fishing lodge**. (B, D)

Day 6 Depart hotel for Vermont. Visit a **Cider Mill**. Tour of the **Shelburne Museum and Vineyards**. Dinner together at **Palmer's Sugar House** before checking into our hotel. (B, D)

Day 7 Meet the owners of **Basin Harbor Resort** and learn the history of the location. Depart for Middlebury. Tour of the **University of Vermont Middlebury Morgan Horse Farm**. A visit to a stunning **Granite Quarry** before heading back to resort for the night. (B, L)

Day 8 Travel to New Hampshire. Explore Hanover, New Hampshire. Choice of the **Hood Museum, King Arthur's Baking, Dartmouth Orchid Collection**, or exploring on your own. Group picture at the **Quechee Gorge** before touring the **Billings Farm and Museum**. Check into our accommodations for the night. (B, D)

Day 9 Travel on the **Mount Washington Cog Railroad** (1 of only 2 in the nation). Lunch on the mountain. Visit an original style **General Store** and learn from the owner about maple sugaring in New England. Check into hotel and enjoy **gondola ride up Loon Mountain**. Enjoy a special dinner with entertainment tonight. (B, D)

Day 10 Travel along the **Kancamagus Scenic Highway**, starting at the White Mountains Visitors Center and ending in North Conway. We make our way to **Boothbay Harbor** and check into our hotel and enjoy the ocean sights, sounds, and smells. (B, D)

Day 11 Narrated cruise along the **Booth Bay coast**. Free time in the Harbor to explore and get lunch. Visit the **Coastal Botanical Gardens** (the largest in New England) before returning to our hotel and enjoying the view of the sunset over the ocean. (B, D)
