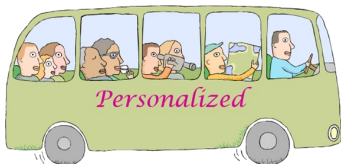

DEFINITION: Motorcoach Driver

Motorcoach "bus" drivers usually transport passengers on chartered trips and tours that may last up to several days. While transporting tour groups, these drivers make sure all passengers are comfortable, on schedule, and safe. 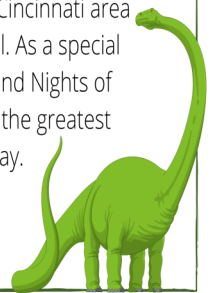

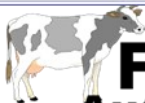

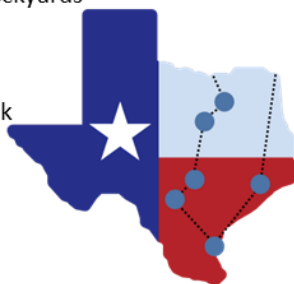
