Meet Our Emma's

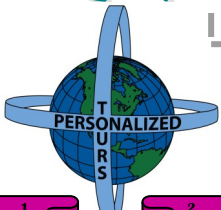

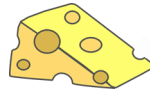

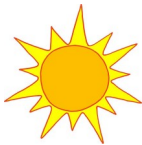
