This afternoon, you may choose a guided optional excursion to the old seaside town of Honfleur. **(B,L,D)** *Overnight docking in Caudebec.*

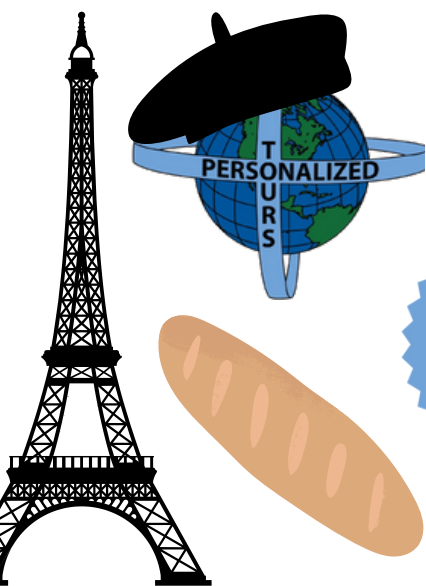
**Friday October 30 - CAUDEBEC. EXCURSION TO NORMANDY** Join a guided tour of Normandy's WWII landing beaches, visit significant U.S. sites, including Omaha Beach, the Ponte du Hoc monument, and the American Cemetery, or take a full-day guided tour of the British and Canadian commemorative sites, including the British Cemetery, Pegasus Memorial, the seaside town of Arromanches, the Juno Beach Center, and the Beny-sur-Mer Canadian War Cemetery. Or instead, join "A Taste of Normandy" guided tour for an in depth look at this rich agricultural region: see the famous Bayeux Tapestry, visit the beautiful village of Beuvron en Auge and taste Calvados at a local distillery. Later, enjoy live entertainment onboard the ship. **(B,L,D)** *Evening cruise to Rouen.*

**Saturday October 31 - ROUEN** Take a guided bike tour to discover and explore the most famous monuments and the lesser-known hidden gems of Rouen on two wheels, or take a guided walking tour of Rouen-site of Saint Joan of Arc's martyrdom-and see the medieval quarter with its 16<sup>th</sup> century Astronomical Clock, and Notre-Dame Cathedral. **(B,L,D)** *Evening / overnight cruise to Conflans.*

**Sunday November 1 CONFLANS** Enjoy a relaxing bike ride along the Seine with your adventure host, or join a guided visit to Auvers-sue-Oise, home and resting pace of Vincent van Gogh, or take a guided tour of the opulent Chateau de Malmaison-home of Napoleon Bonaparte and his wife Josephine.
