Tuesday, May 19th - Off we go! This morning, we board our early flight out of Milwaukee and head to the city that never sleeps, New York City. Upon arrival, we grab an Uber, and drop our luggage at our hotel and spend some time exploring **Times Square**. Take in the sights, enjoy a New York slice, or spend some time shopping at the many name-brand outlets that line the street. We make our way north to **Central Park** for a **rickshaw ride** through the park. Despite being the most well-known, Central Park is actually only the 6th-largest within NYC at 843 acres. It is the most visited urban park in the United States with over 42 million visitors annually. Main attractions within the park include iconic locations such as the Central Park Zoo, Central Park Carousel, Wollman Rink, the Bethesda Terrace, and more. The biologically diverse ecosystem is home to several hundred species of flora and fauna. Our rickshaw driver will show us the highlights. **Dinner** will be at a local favorite known for their delicious cheesecake. We round out our first day in the city with our **first Broadway show**. You will have the choice. (See attached sheet) **(D)**

Wednesday, May 20th - Rise and shine! Our group will enjoy breakfast together before choosing to tour with **Jerry** or splitting off to spend the day how you would like. We will jump on the hop-on bus and head south taking in all the sights and narration along the way. The Battery is located on the southernmost tip of Manhattan and is known for multiple famous landmarks, breathtaking views of the harbor, and more. We will see the **Statue of Liberty** and explore **Ellis Island**, where millions of immigrants took their first steps in America. Upon returning to the mainland, we will have time to see the **9/11 Memorial and Museum**. This museum tells the story of 9/11 through artifacts, imagery, personal stories, and interactive technology. The museum's dynamic blend of architecture, archaeology, and history creates an unforgettable and somber experience. Meet the rest of the group for a ride to the top of the **Empire State Building**. For those of you who choose, you can explore on your own, or with **Tracy**, and head over to **Rockefeller Center**, the **Empire State Building** after a nice walk on the **High Line Elevated Trail**. We will enjoy **dinner** together this evening before **another Broadway show**. See the list below for the shows to choose from. **(B,D)**

Thursday, May 21st - Our last full day in the city, we are going to use every moment! We will spend the day exploring the areas of NYC. Choose how you spend your day as we take a **bus tour of New York**. Hop on and off wherever you would like to plan your day around your interests. We will board the **Circle Line Boat Cruise** and take in the famous NYC landmarks along the harbor. Breathtaking views of Manhattan's downtown and midtown skyline will make this cruise truly special.
