6 Days: September 18 - 23, 2022

Day 1 D

Upon arriving in Spokane, we will board a local coach and check-in at the Coeur d'Alene Casino Resort. The story of Mildred Bailey will be acted and sung by none other than Coeur d'Alene Tribal member CeCe Curtis-Cook. Her performance will take you to the turn of the century when America was going through its struggles and its heyday of the roaring 20's and beyond. Enjoy a night of Food, history, laughter and good ole music that makes you feel right at home.

Day 2 L

Enjoy the cuisine of innovated local Chef Adam Hegsted on a Northwest Foodie Tour. Get ready for some delicious food. After dining enjoy some time to check out the local shops in Downtown Coeur d'Alene. To complete our sightseeing today, we will take a 90 minute boat cruise of Northwest Lake Coeur d'Alene. See a fascinating mix of scenery and wildlife. You'll hear narration that highlights points of interest on Lake Coeur d'Alene such as the gorgeous lake home and the world's only floating golf green.

Day 3 L

Today we will experience Historic Spokane's "Age of Elegance" with a tour of the rich history, historic homes and attractions of Spokane. Learn about the Native Americans that first discovered this area as we travel along the Spokane River. View the Spokane Falls, the grounds of the former Expo '74 site. Feel like a kid again as you take a ride on the historic 1909 Loeffl Carrousel. Discover Manito Park while strolling through the formal French Renaissance Gardens, Perennial Gardens, Rose Gardens and the flower-filled Conservatory. We will enjoy lunch inside an actual boiler and stand under the massive 225' smoke stacks at the Steam Plant.

Day 4 CB

Today is a Majestic Encounter at the Eagle Aviary. The Coeur d'Alene Tribe plays a conservation role for these majestic birds that recover from injury but can't live on their own and need permanent homes. The federal permit allows the Coeur d'Alene tribe to keep captive bald and golden eagles and collect feathers for ceremonial and religious purposes.

Day 5 D

Enjoy a visit to Coeur d'Alene's Old Mission, the oldest building in Idaho. This will provide an educational experience not found anywhere else. Examine the dynamics and complexities between Jesuit missionaries and the tribal people among whom they settled in a beautiful park setting. Tonight experience true tribal hospitality while enjoy traditional storytelling, traditional dancers, drums, music and tribal cuisine.
