**FRIDAY
JULY 28**

Our trip to New York City begins with transportation to Milwaukee International Airport and a morning flight. Upon arrival we are whisked to the ferry that will take us to **Ellis Island National**



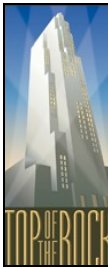
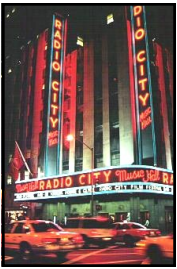
Immigration Museum and the **Statue of Liberty**. Our first stop is Ellis Island, the nation's main point of entry for millions of immigrants. Galleries and exhibits chronicle the history of immigration into the United States. We reboard the ferry for a trip to Manhattan. Get your cameras ready as we see the Statue of Liberty across the New York Harbor. We are off to the **National September 11 Memorial and Museum** including the



newly opened underground museum. Occupying 8 of the 16 acres at the World Trade Center, the memorial is a tribute to the past and a place of hope for the future. The names of every person who died in the terrorist attacks February 26, 1993 and September 11, 2001 are inscribed in bronze. The museum exhibits explore the background leading up to the events and examine their aftermath and continuing implications. Late afternoon finds us checking into our rooms at the Novotel New York Hotel, located in the heart of the Theatre District. Dinner is included at a small Italian bistro. Tonight we see the flashing lights on Broadway, as we are treated to one of **Broadway's biggest hits. (Dinner)**

**SATURDAY
JULY 29**

This morning we walk toward Rockefeller Center with a stop at **St. Patrick's Cathedral**. We will have time to soak in all of its grandeur. Our walk continues to **Radio City Music Hall** for a stage door tour of this historic theatre including an opportunity to talk with one of The Rockettes. There will be time for lunch (on own) and browsing in **Rockefeller Center**. Then it is on to **The Top of**



The Rock observation deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Center for amazing views of Manhattan and the surrounding boroughs. The remainder of the afternoon and evening are free to spend however you choose. Do some serious shopping on Fifth Avenue or take a carriage ride in Central Park. You may wish to visit TKTs discount ticket booth in Times Square to pick up Broadway show tickets for this evening. Our tour director, New York representative, and the concierge at the hotel will be glad to assist you with your plans.



**SUNDAY
JULY 30**

A local guide joins us for a **motorcoach tour of Upper Manhattan**. We drive to **Harlem**, stopping at the **Cathedral of Saint John the Divine** and **Grant's Tomb**. Enjoy a walk through Central Park with a visit to **Strawberry**



Fields, a 2 1/2- acre landscaped section of the park dedicated to the memory of former Beatle, John Lennon. Following our return to the Novotel we will have lunch in one of New York's famous delis. The rest of the afternoon and evening are free to further explore Manhattan. You may want to take an optional double-decker bus tour of Lower Manhattan to visit Chinatown, Greenwich Village, and the Empire State Building. **(Lunch)**

**MONDAY
JULY 31**

Our last day in New York is spent **touring Brooklyn**, one of New York City's five boroughs, situated on the western end of Long Island. The iconic Brooklyn Bridge, built in 1883, connects it to Manhattan, along with the Manhattan Bridge and the Williamsburg Bridge. Our first stop is at Coney Island. There will be plenty of time



to grab a Nathan's hot dog, stroll the beach, and check out the boardwalk. Our tour continues around the neighborhoods of Brooklyn. The varied neighborhoods range from Williamsburg, a hotbed of music, art, and nightlife to beachfront Coney Island. Brooklyn Heights and Park Slope are among its leafy, row house-filled districts. Brooklyn contains the most ethnic diversity of any of the boroughs. The Hasidic Jews, with their traditions and beliefs, live side by side in peace with many other ethnic groups. Option: You may choose to forego the tour to Brooklyn and stay in Manhattan. Late afternoon we transfer to the airport.
