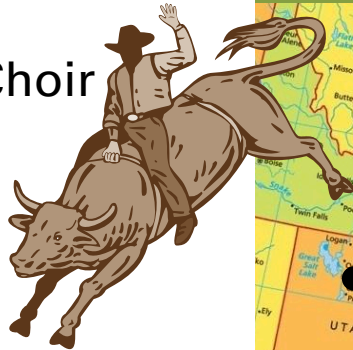

Map At A Glance



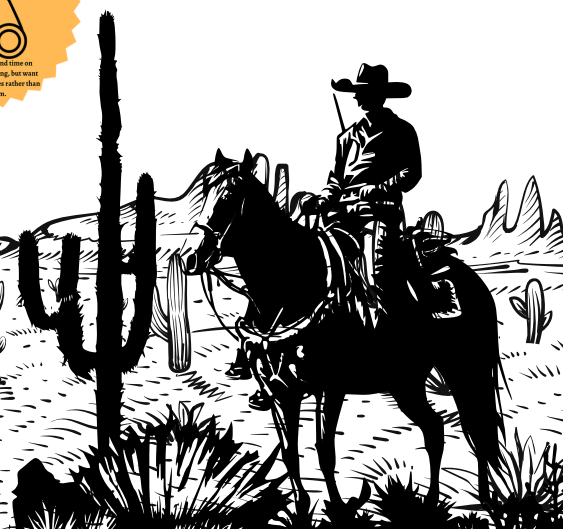
