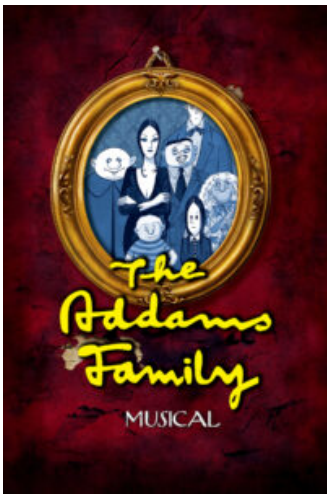
Beehive - The '60s Musical January 22 & 30

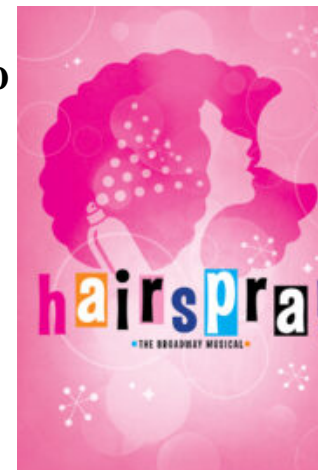
The Addams Family Musical February 27 & March 12

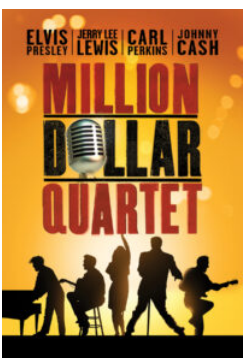
Hairspray - The Broadway Musical April 24 & 30

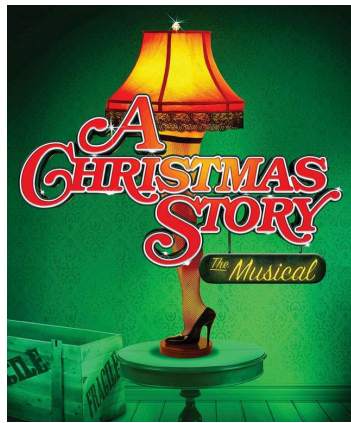


Disney's Frozen July 24 & 30
